## Shred Documents & Recycle Electronics April 7, 2018



NOTE: Info on proper disposal options for fat tube TVs and monitors

The free community service was offered between 9 a.m. and noon on Saturday, April 7 at the Jefferson Ruritan Club in Jefferson, Maryland. Over 120 people were served and nearly 95% made voluntary contributions. Donors had the option of choosing to support either or both of these causes:

- School construction and scholarships in Africa administered by Able & Willing International Education Foundation, Inc.
- The Jefferson Ruritan Scholarship Fund administered by the Community Foundation of Frederick County.

## Processing Results:

- 3.7 tons of documents were safely shredded
- 1.1 tons of electronic items were responsibly recycled and electronic data securely destroyed
- 10 Certificates of Data Destruction were issued (\$5 each, not tax deductible).
- 14 fat monitors and TVs were collected for recycling for fee (not tax deductible).

## Income:

• Gross Income = \$3,484.00

• Expenses = \$ 590.44

Net Income = \$2,893.56

The profits were divided according to donor preferences (If no donor preference were specified, donations were divided in proportion to number of volunteers and transportation equipment provided by the respective organizations.):

- Net to Able & Willing for school construction and scholarships in Africa = \$ 1,391.39.
- Net to the Jefferson Ruritan Scholarship Fund administered by the Community Foundation of Frederick County = \$1,502.17.
