We do ask that all workers at the carnival be at least **14 years of age** if involved with food prep / swerving. This is for safety reasons.

The Jefferson Ruritan Community Carnival is truly a community event. It does take a commitment of time and energy from all members. It can also be a time of great fellowship that has lasting memories. Just listen to some of the stories of those who have been involved in the past.

PREPARATIONS

There is no specific committee for set-up. This is a TOTAL CLUB commitment. All are expected to give time to get the grounds prepared, as well as to perform numerous other tasks that need to be completed prior to opening night.

Kitchen help is needed throughout the week in prep for evening dinners. Assistance is needed in morning during the carnival starting around 8am. No experience necessary.

Country ham preparation involves the boning and cooking of our popular country ham. Again, no experience is necessary. Check the schedule below and plan on giving several hours to complete the tasks. All work is completed in the pavilion area.

Grounds preparation will commence on **Monday, July 23, 2018** at 5:30pm, and will be held each evening until all tasks completed (generally Mon-Thurs.). It involves cleaning of the pavilion/kitchen, setting up bingo, arranging the garage areas for games, and grooming of the grounds. The more who show up to assist lessens the load for a few and completes tasks in less evenings.
